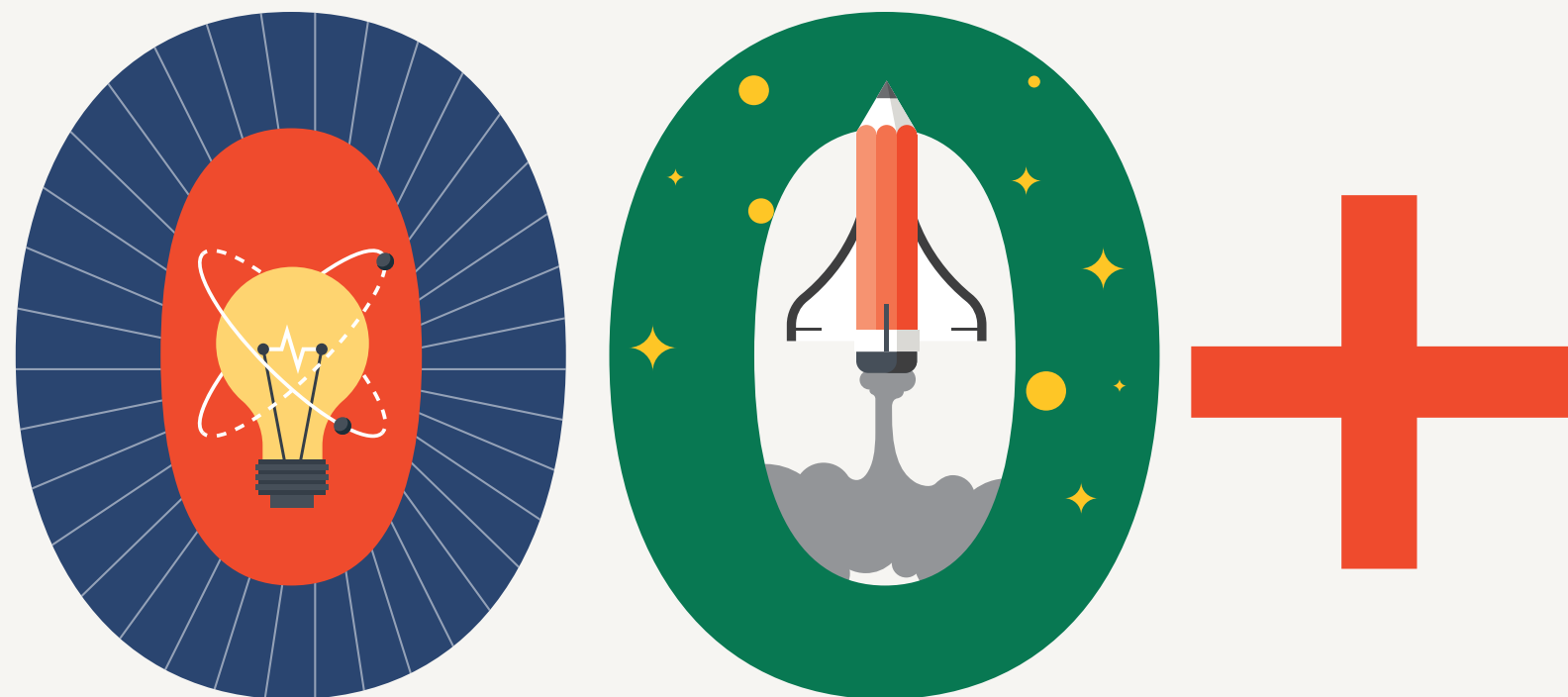

And by getting the information you need, you'll make it a more successful one.

New York's independent colleges and universities are each different in so many ways. But there are a few shared elements you'll find at all of them: generous financial aid, small class sizes, personal attention, distinguished faculty, unparalleled experiential learning opportunities, strong global alumni networks, and unmatched support services to help you finish your degree on time.

In this book, you'll find tips to help you make the most of your college search, and an overview of each of the 100+ independent colleges and universities in New York.

If you know what you're looking for, search through this book to find colleges by major (pages 34–49) or geographic location (pages 6–9), then learn more about them in their campus profiles (pages 12–29). In addition, review the Campus Quick Facts section for other interesting characteristics (pages 30–33). For information on paying for college, check out pages 50–67.

If you don't know where to start, that's okay, too—in fact, it's perfectly understandable. Fill out the worksheet on page 11, and talk through your choices with your school counselor, college advisor, parent, or guardian.

Beyond this book, there are other ways to explore your options and stay on track:

- Attend virtual or in-person college fairs to speak to admissions representatives and learn about colleges directly from the source.
- Make a virtual or in-person visit to colleges that interest you — many colleges are now offering virtual tours for students who are not able to travel. Check the social media accounts for colleges that interest you to learn more about their personality. Contact their admissions departments to ask questions about campus life and academic areas that interest you.
- Understand your financial aid options.
- Make a short list of eight or nine colleges that interest you, and see if you can talk to current students or graduates.
- Create a calendar to help you remember the admission and financial aid deadlines for each college you're applying to.

What you should consider when choosing a college...

Every private college is unique, with its own culture, campus environment, and academic focus. Taken together, these institutions represent a broad spectrum of opportunities, and an almost limitless number of programs to study. With so many options, there's a lot to consider.

First, consider the academic and campus experience.

- Academic departments: Do they have what you're looking for in an area of study?
- Class size: Do you prefer large lecture halls or smaller, intimate groups?
- Student-faculty ratios: Do you want close relationships with your professors?
- Faculty: Do they focus on teaching or do they focus on research?
- Out-of-classroom opportunities: How soon—and how often—will you be able to dig into real-world work, like research, internships, or study-abroad programs?
- A STEM-focused education: Do you want to focus on science, technology, engineering, and/or math?
- A holistic education: Do you want an education that incorporates critical thinking and emphasizes developing well-rounded skills?
- Internship and career placement services: How invested will this college be in helping you secure an internship or a career?
- Campus setting and surrounding area: Do you want a quiet and remote location, a quintessential college town, or a bustling urban setting?
- Campus life, residence halls, dining plans: You'll make this place your home for the next few years. Will the physical spaces and the culture of the campus work for you?

And, of course, consider the value.

New York's independent colleges and universities are known for dedicated, world-class faculty; low student-faculty ratios; and immersive, experiential study. These things sometimes cost money—but not as much as you might think. Don't write off a college based on the published tuition price, because it's probably not what you'll pay. Private colleges help families meet college costs through grants, scholarships, and other aid.

...and what college admissions will consider when they're choosing you.

While you're evaluating your best-fit colleges, they're evaluating you, too. Here are some things colleges may consider when making admission decisions:

- **Academic preparation:** Are you ready for the next level of your academic journey, and do you have the potential to be successful at this college?
- **Challenging coursework:** Have you pushed yourself academically, taking AP classes and more advanced curriculum?
- **Good grades in a range of courses:** Do you excel across the board, earning high marks in a diverse array of classes?
- **Recommendations from teachers and mentors:** What insights have the adults in your life shared about the work you've done so far and the potential they see in you?
- **Written self-expression:** Is your essay or writing sample articulate, compelling, and engaging?
- **Interest in and enthusiasm for the college:** Do you have a strong passion for the college you're applying to?
- **SAT and ACT scores:** This is optional at many colleges, but if the college or program you're applying to requires it, how well did you score?
- **Extracurricular activities:** Commitment matters over quantity. Did you serve in any leadership positions? Do you have a long track record of participation?
- **Ranking among high school peers:** How do you stack up among your classmates?
- **Verbal expression and presentation:** Are you confident, poised, and genuine in your meetings with representatives of the college?

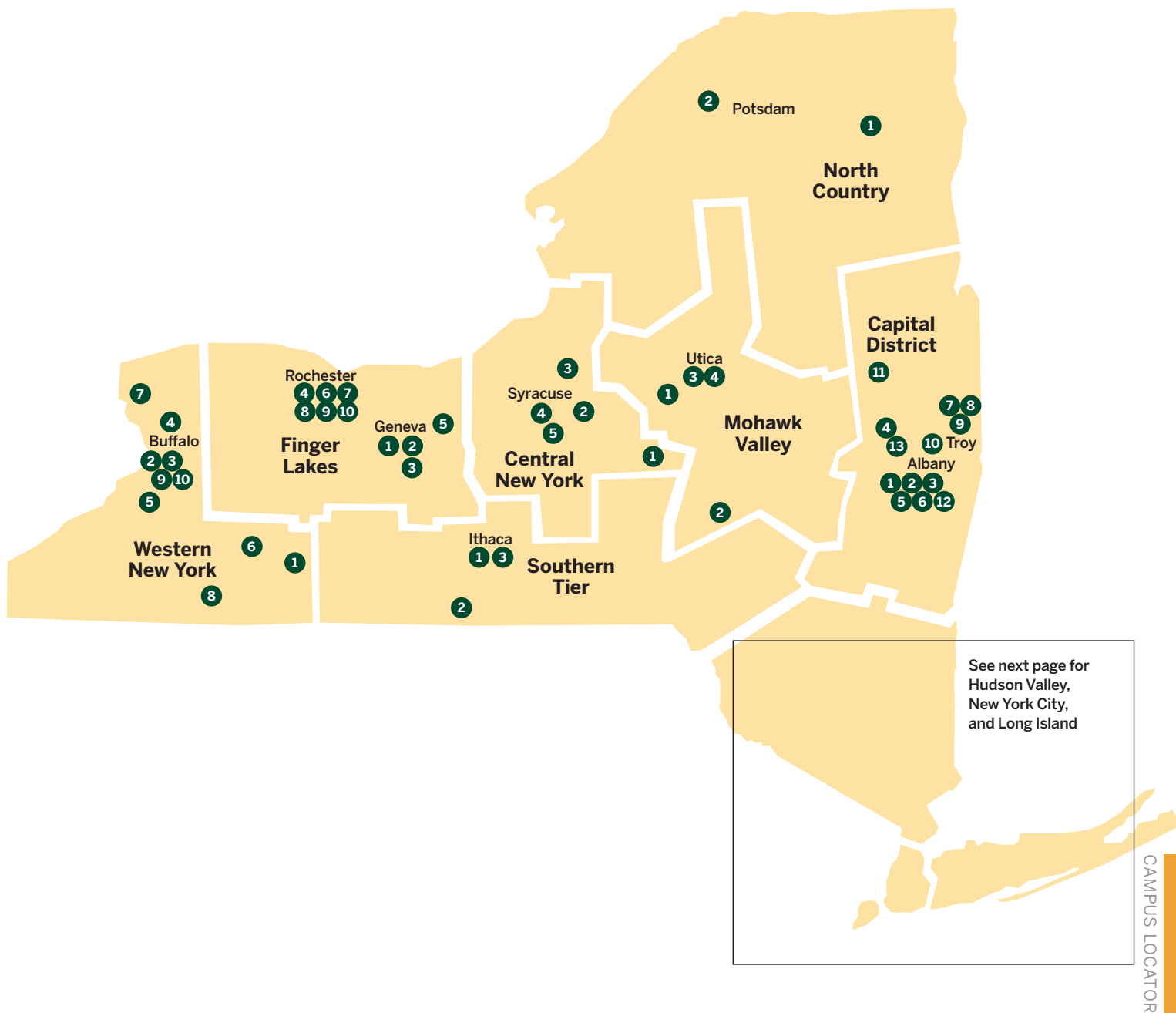

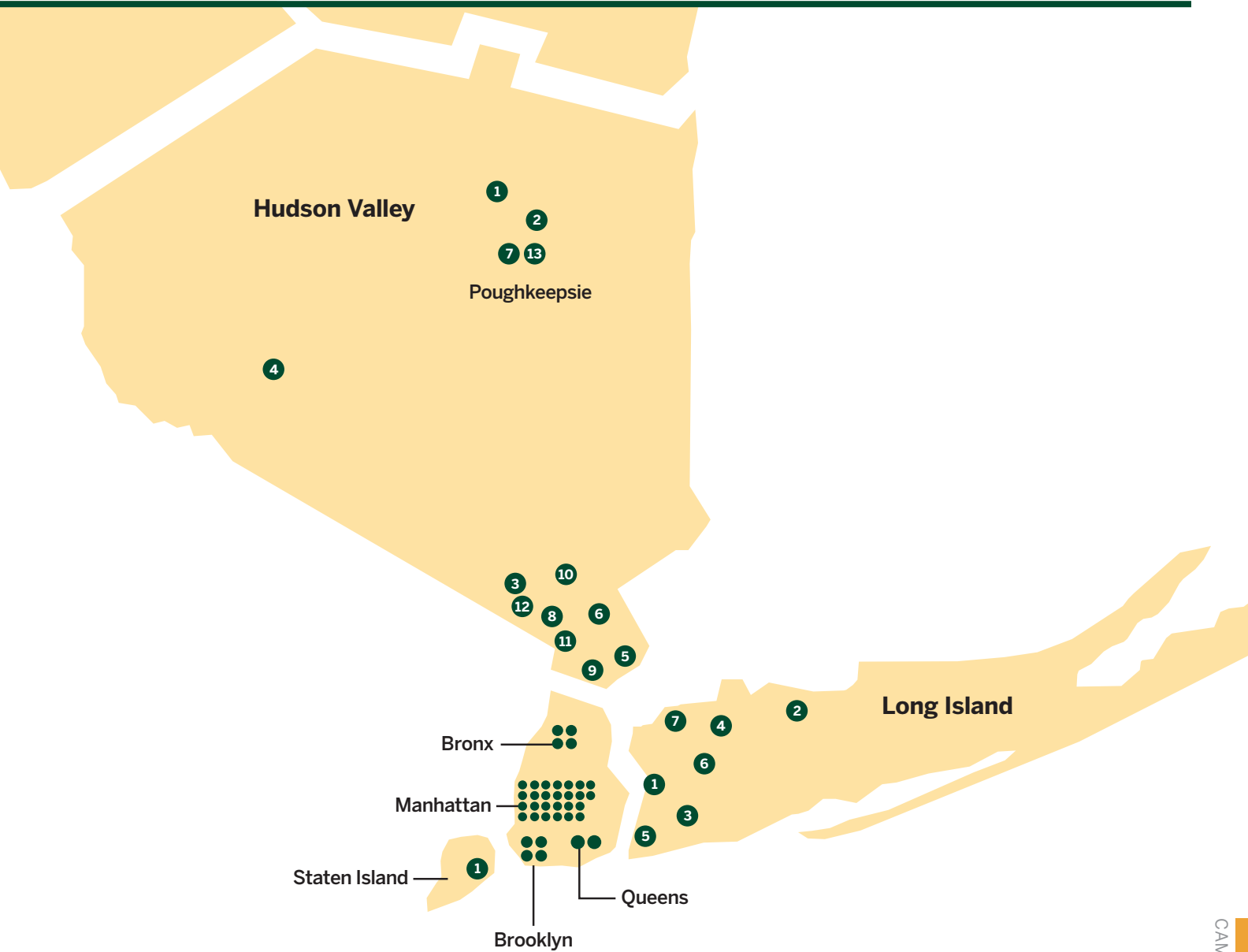

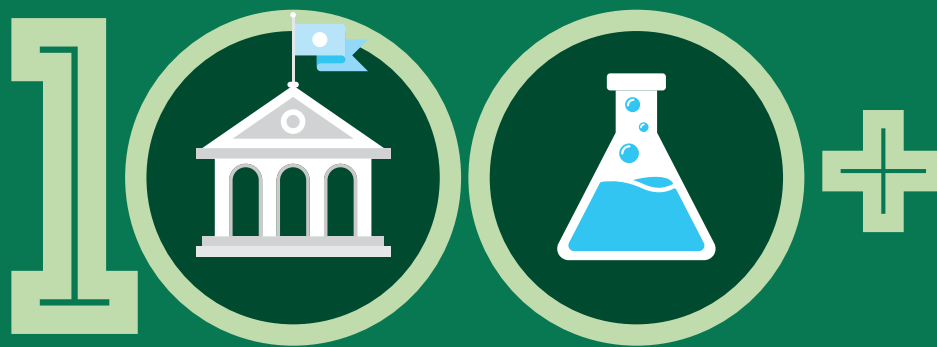

New York's network of independent colleges and universities is vast—and so are the opportunities they provide for extraordinary experiences, personal support, and fulfilling careers.

In this section, you'll find the need-to-know details for every college in that network. And if you see something that intrigues you, you'll have the information you need to take your search to the next level.

Of course, the best way to learn more about a college is to ask questions. So call, write, or email the campus admissions staff, and plan a visit if you can. Attend college fairs and leave your name with representatives from the colleges that interest you.

Note: The information listed in this section is intended as a set of general campus profiles. Always check with the campus directly to verify information.

When it comes to choosing a college, the options can be overwhelming. Don't know where to start? This is a good place.

Associate

College Terminology

Annual College Costs — Includes tuition, fees, room, board, books, transportation, and personal expenses. These costs vary from college to college.

Application Deadline — The date, set by a college admissions office, by which applications for admission must be received.

Associate Degree — Degree awarded on completion of a (usually) two-year program of study.

Average Net Price — The average cost first-year undergraduate students pay for tuition, fees, room, and board minus any scholarships and grants you may receive (Academic year: 2024-25).

Bachelor's (or Baccalaureate) Degree — Degree awarded on completion of a (usually) four-year program of study.

Common Application — An application for admission accepted by more than 1,000 colleges. Check with the college.

Early Action — A non-binding early application process that allows students to learn the college's admission decision before the college's official notification date.

Early Decision — A binding early application process. Students are notified of acceptance and are expected to commit to enrollment before regular applicants.

Financial Aid — Aid to assist in meeting college costs that may be in the form of grants, scholarships, loans, or work-study. Always meet these application deadlines. See pages 54-61 for more information about financial aid.

First Professional Degree — Study that culminates in a degree and license in a profession such as law, medicine, etc.

Graduate and Professional Study — Work toward a master's or doctoral degree, post-graduate certificate, or professional license.

Interview — A conversation with a college admission or faculty representative, or with alumni.

Master's Degree and Doctoral Degree — Advanced degrees awarded for completion of additional study beyond a bachelor's (usually four-year) degree.

Recommendation — A written assessment of the student's aptitudes, abilities, and interests written by a teacher, counselor, coach, etc.

Rolling Admission — An institution reviews applications as they are received and offers a decision to students as applications are reviewed.

Room and Board — College housing and meal plans (often several options are available).

SAT and ACT — Standardized tests that measure verbal and math proficiency, used by some colleges as a variable to predict the likelihood of a student's success at their college.

Undergraduate Study — Work toward a two-year (associate) degree or a four- or five-year (bachelor's) degree.

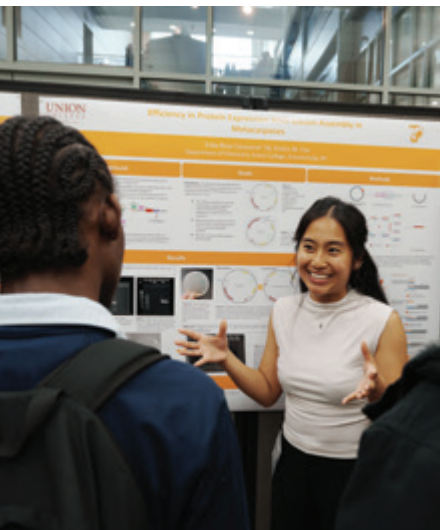

We've said it before, but it's worth repeating: the published price isn't necessarily the actual amount you'll pay. So don't write off your dream college just because you think it might be too expensive. Instead, apply to colleges that fit the criteria you're looking for and talk to admissions and financial aid counselors to get more information about available funding.

There are many options to make college more affordable, including:

- Grants and scholarships from colleges, and from federal and state governments
- Job programs on or off campus
- Benefits offered by employers
- Competitive scholarships from civic and religious organizations
- Scholarships offered by professional organizations for study in specific academic subjects or toward certain professions
- Tax deductions or credits for eligible educational expenses

10 simple questions

to make the most of your financial aid discussions

As you're discussing your options with college representatives, these are important questions to ask:

- 1 Which forms are required to be considered for all forms of aid?
- 2 What are your requirements for merit aid?*
- 3 Will my financial aid be the same next year? How do I keep it? How do I renew it?
- 4 What are the financial aid application deadlines?
- 5 Are there state aid programs I should know about?
- 6 When will you notify me of my aid eligibility?
- 7 How will outside scholarships affect my financial aid package?
- 8 Are there special requirements, such as grades or course sequences, for keeping my grants and scholarships?
- 9 Are there other conditions that I must meet, like stipulations on where I must live or work after graduation?
- 10 Do you have a payment plan for paying tuition monthly?



*Merit aid is money that is awarded by a college for a student's academic achievement or special talents or traits. It doesn't take into account a student's financial needs.

† Need-based aid is awarded solely on the basis of a student's financial need.



Steps to conquering the financial aid process

A private college education is an investment in your future that will benefit you for a lifetime. There are resources available to put tuition within your reach. To take full advantage of those resources, follow the steps below.

Step 1

Every college has different requirements and deadlines for financial aid forms. Check with each college's financial aid office or website to determine which forms you need to file to be considered for all types of financial aid. Here are the most common ones:

- **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** — Everyone applying for federal aid and most other financial aid must complete this free form, as early as possible. You and a parent (if you are their dependent) will each need to create an FSA ID to file the FAFSA.

- **NYS Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) Application** — If you're an eligible New York resident attending a college in the state, use this free form with the FAFSA to apply for a NYS TAP grant and NYS scholarship awards. You can link directly to the TAP application from the FAFSA submission confirmation page.

For more information, contact the NYS Higher Education Services Corporation at hesc.ny.gov/find-aid/nys-grants-scholarships/tuition-assistance-program-tap/.
- **CSS Profile™** — Some colleges may ask you to file the CSS Profile™ form to be considered for college-funded aid (the college's own grants and scholarships).

Visit cssprofile.collegeboard.org to file. There is a fee for filing this form, but fee waivers are available for eligible students.
- **College-specific financial aid applications** — Some colleges may ask you to complete their financial aid applications to be considered for their college-funded grants, scholarships, and loans. Check with each college for application requirements and deadlines.

Tip: Get your FSA ID ahead of time to minimize delays. Go to studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account/launch

The road to college has so many exciting stops! Financial aid is one of the first and most important steps along the way to finding the right college. You should complete the FAFSA even if you don't think you qualify for student aid.

Step 2

Complete and file the FAFSA (studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa) as soon as possible once it is available. NYS residents applying to colleges in the state should include a NYS college on their FAFSA to begin the application for a NYS TAP grant.

By filing the FAFSA, you will be considered for:

- Grants and scholarships from private colleges and universities (Note: Some colleges require additional forms)
- Federal Pell Grant
- Federal Work-Study (FWS)
- Job programs from private colleges and universities
- Federal Direct Student Loan
- Iraq and Afghanistan Service Grant

Visit StudentAid.gov for more information. Note: You must submit a FAFSA form every year to renew your financial aid.

When you're comparing colleges, focus on the net price, not the sticker price. The net price is the total cost of tuition and fees, minus any grants, scholarships, and other aid you receive. It is the actual amount you will pay.

Step 3

After submitting the FAFSA online, you'll receive a link to your FAFSA Submission Report via email. Review the report carefully and follow directions to correct your FAFSA data, if necessary.

Step 4

Each college that accepts you for admission will send a financial aid offer. Each college's aid package may include a different combination of grants, scholarships, work-study, and loans to help you meet college expenses. Compare each college's financial aid offer by determining the college's "net cost" — just subtract the amount of all grants, scholarships, and student loan funding from the published tuition, fees, room, and board. If you have questions or concerns, talk to the admissions or financial aid representative at the college. They are available to help you navigate this process.

Step 5

The financial aid packages and aid amounts you receive will vary from college to college since each college will put together a package just for you, based on your family's circumstances and the college's cost of attendance.

Carefully consider the offers of admission and financial aid you've received. Be sure to respond to the college's offer of admission and financial aid by the deadline indicated. The deadline at colleges with traditional admission deadlines is May 1. For colleges with rolling admission; apply as early as possible since spots may fill up quickly.

When reviewing the financial aid offer from the college, be certain to pay attention to:

- **Completing your federal loan application:** The college will send instructions about the loan application process, which includes the completion of a form called the master promissory note (MPN) and an entrance counseling session. It is important to keep track of how much you are borrowing and the loan repayment terms and conditions.

- **Completing your NYS TAP application:** If you're an eligible New York resident attending college in the state, follow up on the NYS TAP grant and other state-specific aid programs.

Step 6

Always keep in mind that financial aid isn't a one-time endeavor—there are conditions for keeping it, like required grades and coursework. Make sure to renew your financial aid each year, on time, to avoid losing it.

Whatever your needs and your financial situation, there are programs out there that can help you pay for college. You'll find a listing of some of the most important financial aid programs on the next few pages.

Grants and Scholarships*

Grants and scholarships are funds you do not have to repay. They are available from colleges, your state, the federal government, professional and service organizations, private foundations, and many employers. Some grants are based on your financial need, while others are awarded for academic merit, a specific career goal, a special talent, or group affiliation.

Grants and Scholarships from NYS Private Colleges and Universities: More than \$8.5 billion is awarded each year. Check with each college's financial aid office to determine which forms you need to complete to be considered for all types of need-based and merit-based aid.

Federal Programs

Federal Iraq and Afghanistan Service Grant: Up to the maximum Pell Grant for eligible children of service members who died during service in Iraq or Afghanistan after 9/11. To apply, file the FAFSA.

Federal Pell Grant: A grant based on financial need. To apply, file the FAFSA.

Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grants (FSEOG): Awards are based on need. To apply, file the FAFSA.

New York State Programs

ADA Part-Time TAP: Students with a documentable disability may be eligible for ADA Part-Time Tuition Assistance Program (TAP), which allows students additional time to complete their college program while receiving TAP.

Arthur O. Eve Higher Education Opportunity Program (HEOP): Provides academic support and financial assistance to students at participating colleges who might not meet all the traditional college admissions criteria but who show promise of succeeding in college. Go to nysed.gov/postsecondary-services/higher-education-opportunity-program-heop

Collegiate Science and Technology Entry Program (CSTEP): Provides academic enrichment and research experience in STEM content areas (science, technology, engineering, math, health-related careers, and the licensed professions) to eligible students who attend participating colleges. Go to nysed.gov/postsecondary-services/collegiate-science-and-technology-entry-program-cstep

Enhanced Tuition Awards: Provides eligible New York State students who attend participating private, not-for-profit colleges. Also includes a comparable amount from the college. Applications open during a limited time each year. Other requirements apply. Go to hesc.ny.gov for more information.

Part-Time TAP: Awards for eligible undergraduate students attending college part time.

Sen. José Peralta NYS DREAM Act: Undocumented students (including students with DACA status), students who hold certain types of visas, and others may be eligible for New York State-administered grants and scholarships. For more information and eligibility details, go to hesc.ny.gov/dream.

Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) grants at private colleges and universities: Eligible students attending an NYS college full time may receive an award. To apply, file the FAFSA and link to the TAP application from the FAFSA confirmation page.

Scholarships from private sources: Grants and scholarships are available from many community organizations, businesses, corporations, unions, and churches. Check with your school counselor, public library, employer, chamber of commerce, union, church, community, and special interest organizations.

Did you know?

Most of the financial aid that students at private colleges receive comes directly from their college — 89% of the aid first-year students receive is college-funded.

Work-Study*

Work-study programs give you the opportunity to earn money while you're in college by working part time on campus or in the community.

Federal Work-Study Program (FWS): Provides jobs to undergraduate and graduate students with financial need. To apply, file the FAFSA.

Job programs from private colleges and universities: Check with the college's financial aid office for on-campus job availability. Community service jobs are also available for work-study students.

Education Loans*

Education loans for college costs may be available for you and/or your parents. This aid must be repaid, usually with interest. Some loans are based on financial need. Federal education loans often provide the lowest interest rates.

For federal loans, file the appropriate loan application at studentaid.gov/understand-aid/types/loans

Wherever you are in the college search journey, use this guide to make sure you're on track. Missed some milestones? Don't panic. Talk to your counselor and see how you can catch up. It's never too late to find the right college.

IF YOU'RE A **SOPHOMORE**

In the Fall

- Meet with your school counselor early in the school year to make sure you're taking the right classes to graduate and be ready for college. Most colleges require a full sequence of courses in the major subject areas (English, math, science, etc.). Also, ask for help in developing a list of colleges based on your interests. (Use the worksheet on page 11 as a starting point.)
- Get involved at your school and in your community. Most colleges will look at your participation in extracurricular activities when considering your college application.
- Stay engaged in your classes and get extra help from your teacher, counselor, or others if you need it.

In the Spring

- Start thinking about your class schedule for next year.
- Meet with your school counselor and talk about your college path. Be sure to bring a list of questions about college. Here are some suggestions:

- What classes do I need to take to graduate? What classes should I take to be ready for college?
 - What elective classes should I take?
 - Would you recommend that I take any AP or honors courses?
 - How should I study for the SAT or the ACT? Does the school offer any help?
 - Can you help me develop a list of colleges to research based on my interests and the type of college I want to attend? (Use the worksheet on page 11 as a starting point.)
 - Do you have information about college fairs that I should attend?
- Think about your summer plans and consider including an internship, job, volunteer position, or summer academic program.



A NOTE ABOUT STANDARDIZED TESTING:

Be sure to check with the colleges and universities you're interested in to understand their standardized testing requirements for applicants.

IF YOU'RE A **JUNIOR**

In the Fall

- Talk to your school counselor about whether you should take any standardized tests. Some colleges and universities have "test-optional" policies and don't require students to submit their SAT or ACT scores. Other colleges require them.
- Attend college fairs and talk with college representatives. Ask them about campus life, application requirements, and financial aid.
- Work with your school counselor, college advisor, parent, or guardian to develop a list of eight to ten colleges that interest you. Use the worksheet on page 11 as a starting point. Research the colleges on your list, keeping track of your questions and the things that you like about each college.
- Obtain an FSA ID needed to complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Your parent or guardian will need an FSA ID as well.

In the Spring

- Meet with your school counselor to ensure that you're still on track to graduate and are taking the right courses to prepare for college. If you have gaps to fill in, now is the time to review your course selections for senior year.
- Explore the career paths and subjects you might want to study in college. Attend a career fair or shadow a professional in a field you're interested in to learn more about their work and the path they took to get there.
- Research scholarships from outside sources like local businesses, organizations, employers, unions, churches, etc. Be sure to note application deadline dates.
- Plan and schedule summer visits to the colleges on your list.
- Stay involved in extracurricular activities; consider a summer job, internship, or volunteer position.

IF YOU'RE A **SENIOR**

In the Fall and Winter

- Stay on track to graduate—make sure to stay focused, and ask for help if you need it.
- Take the SAT or ACT if necessary.
- Schedule visits to colleges that interest you. Narrow down your list to about five colleges that you plan to apply to.
- On your list of colleges, write down each college's application deadlines, requirements, and fees. Staying organized is key.
- Ask teachers, counselors, and mentors for letters of recommendation for your college applications. Pay attention to how many recommendations you need, guidelines about who should write them, and the required format.
- Attend financial aid workshops.
- Begin to gather the materials you'll need to complete the FAFSA, which is critical to securing financial aid. Most colleges recommend you complete it as soon as possible to maximize the amount of aid you receive. New York students should include a college or university in the state on your list of colleges so you can begin to file the state's

Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) grant application at the end of the FAFSA.

- Stay committed to your extracurricular activities.
- Work on your college applications and your financial aid applications. Be sure to keep track of all requirements and deadlines.
- Complete your applications carefully, including the essay if required. Pay attention to details, proofread everything, and be sure to submit them on time.
- Some colleges require a mid-year grade report—work with your school counselor to send that information to the colleges.
- Look for your college acceptance notices and pay attention to important paperwork and deposit deadlines.

In the Spring

- Plan for your summer job or internship.
- If you're taking Advanced Placement (AP courses), check with your school counselor for details about exam dates and the school's plans for administration of the AP exams.

- Stay focused—most college acceptances are contingent on students maintaining good standing in their senior year.
- Review the financial aid packages you receive from colleges and calculate your net costs. If you have questions, contact the colleges' financial aid offices.
- If possible, make any last college visits before you make a final decision.
- **Decision time:** Choose the college you will attend, sign a letter of intent, accept or refuse financial aid, and send in the required deposits by the college's stated deadlines. The traditional date to notify colleges of your decision is **May 1**.
- Follow up on your grants, scholarships, loans, and any other aid you received.
- Celebrate! Don't forget to send a thank-you note or email to everyone who helped you through your college search.
